### Dr Dianna DeVore resigns

The Australian Stem Cell Centre Ltd (ASCC) announced today that Dr. Dianna DeVore has resigned as the Vice President, Clinical Cardiac Development of the ASCC to pursue other opportunities overseas.

Effective from 31 December 2005, Dr DeVore will relocate back to the United States but will continue to act as a consultant for the ASCC, particularly in the area of international education and stem cell community collaborations.
